14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Miami Diaper Bank's innovative Mobile Diaper Pantry program will fill a gap in services for at-need children and parents in Miami-Dade by directly distributing free diapers to communities with limited or no access to services. By removing barriers to access for undeserved and under-reached children and their parents, Miami Diaper Bank will support improved community health and wellness.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Staff oversight and support for program operations and administration
Consultative support for new program development, best practice and evaluation
Purchase and build out of Mobile Diaper Pantry vehicle
Purchase of wholesale diapers for mobile distribution

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Diapers and related supplies will be distributed directly to undeserved and under-reached participants in Miami-Dade Links to other accessible local services will be provided to participants in Miami-Dade Awareness about Miami Diaper Bank and accessible services will be increased across South Florida Awareness about diaper need will be increased across South Florida

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project is over 800 economically disadvantaged Miami-Dade children ages 0-5 and their parents. This includes participants who are jobless, homeless, in foster care, and have limited or no access to diapers.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Outcomes include measurable improvements in infant and child physical health, maternal mental health, access to childcare, economic self-sufficiency, and an increase in attendance at work for parents and caregivers. Outcomes will be measured using intake surveys administered to participants on-site at mobile distributions and electronic post-distribution surveys to evaluate changes that occurred. Anecdotal reports and testimonials may also be collected from participants.
