Changes to parking will also result in and increase in the number of formal parking spaces and provide for greater safety for pedestrians and vehicles on and around the site.

Additional visitors including elderly, physically disabled, and school students from preschool through University will have an increased opportunity to visit the facility to learn from and enjoy the cultural resources contained therein.

Improved parking facilities in compliance with Federal Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. Also improvement of onsite drainage to prevent standing water in parking and walkway areas.
