a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding will complete Phase One of the Police Athletic Leagues (PAL) Center Renovation. PAL is an integral aspect of the city's plan to engage at-risk youth by building proactive partnerships.

Repayment of Funds

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Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) and Police Athletic Leagues (PAL) projects will improve efforts to engage at-risk youth through building relationships and working closely with community members to form proactive partnerships. Expanding the PAL Teen Center to include a multi-purpose field which includes lighting, viewing stands, concession stands, bathrooms,parking, and drainage.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The program provides direct mentorship programs and leadership opportunities for at risk youth within the community, reaching historically impoverished areas and children.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Over 2000 people are continually served by this program, The target is to reach at risk and disadvantaged youth.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Over 2000 people are continually served by this program, the intention is to involve children and youth in alternative programming that fosters connection and mentorship instead of crime alternatives. This will be measured over the course of less incarceration and increase in sports programs.
