The purpose for the requested funds is to construct a new City Hall building at a City-owned location. The existing City Hall building still suffers damages from Hurricane Michael, including a leaking roof and structural issues in one end of the building. The proposed City Hall building will offer a safe and welcoming site for residents and City workers and will be built to be compliant with the most current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements to accommodate all citizens. The new site will also provide an improved traffic flow with a parking lot and drive-through that are easily accessible.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The existing site is in a high-traffic area with difficult access to the drive through window. The new building site will be designed with providing safe ingress and egress in mind for residents and employees by creating easier access for parking and drive through. The new building will also provide a safer facility for the City employees as well as those that do business there. This will further allow the City to relocate from the existing facilities which are still suffering from damages due to Hurricane Michael.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The existing site is in a high-traffic area with difficult access to the parking lot and drive through window. The new site will be designed with safe ingress and egress in mind. Furthermore, an updated council room for public meetings will be provided and will allow the City to have all of their primary administrative functions in one location.

The target population is the City of Blountstown.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will result in a new City Hall and meeting complex. The project will be designed to provide safe ingress and egress, ADA compliant facilities, and a safer facility that is not damaged from Hurricane Michael.

The City will work with the contracting agency to determine applicable measures, should funding be made available.
