14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

By calendar year 2030 during AM & PM peak hours, the signalized intersections are expected to experience unacceptable (LOS F) results. Intersection capacity improvements are needed prior to 2030. Constructing SR A1A corridor intersection enhancements will alleviate existing and future traffic congestion. The NFTPO & FDOT are extensively involved in study & design phases. Ponte Vedra Beach Citizens Traffic Task Force fully supports project need.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Requested construction funding aims to alleviate current and projected traffic congestion at these intersections thereby improving transportation system Level of Service (LOS) to St. Johns County residents and motoring public.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This major collector link currently exhibits decreased Level of Service (LOS). It is anticipated that SR A1A traffic volume will increase, further degrading A1A corridor LOS. The direct service provided to citizens will be A1A corridor increased LOS following construction completion.

- 1) Improved transportation conditions The improvements will decrease congestion and total lost time at these major intersections along the A1A corridor with additional capacity for anticipated growth in the area. Annual traffic counts and reduction of traffic incidents. 2) Increase economic activity Construction related jobs and spending on goods and services which will be measure through average wage and increase in land values. 3) Job opportunities It is anticipated that the project will immediately create at least 25 construction-related job opportunities. Outcome measurement is an audit of successful contractor's employment records
