#### 14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

St. Johns County PAL serves as an athletic league and character program (Football, Cheer, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Boxing, Police Explorers and Teen Leadership) to more than 2,500 youth annually and struggles to compete for field space due availability. St. Johns County has donated 35 acres for this project. The funding would provide PAL with a permanent home and help promote a friendly environment for the youthful participants and their families as 40% of those struggling with poverty reside in the primary service area of St. Johns PAL.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Football, Cheer, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Boxing, Police Explorers and Teen Leadership programs.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The funding would provide PAL with a permanent home and help promote a friendly environment for the youthful participants and their families as 40% of those struggling with poverty reside in the primary service area of St. Johns PAL.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

County-wide youth 5-18 years of age in need of assistance, character development, physical and mental fitness, and sportsmanship. 2,500 - 5,000 youth and their families to be served annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefits would help PAL promote a friendly environment for the youthful participants and their families, and law enforcement officers. The goal is to provide young people who come through our programs with the foundation and motivation to excel in their lives and become successful, law-abiding citizens. The methodology by which outcomes would be measured by analyzing the sports participation and character development program rates.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
