#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City is requesting funding to provide critically needed counseling and mental heath support services for students in VPK Wrap-Around and K-8th. The program targets low to moderate income persons and allows for families categorized as Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed (ALICE), who depend on affordable and/or subsidized childcare the ability to work.



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#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The program provides year round mental health, counseling and enrichment programming from 1:30-6:00 PM daily to very low-income to moderate students in grades VPK Wrap-Around and kindergarten to 8th. Services include, homework assistance, tutoring, performing arts, cultural enrichment, physical education, file trips, nutritional meals, counseling, transportation, parent engagement and resources.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The program provides year-round enrichment, counseling, mental heath support services, and transportation to 175 very low to moderate income youth and their families.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Persons with poor mental health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, the developmentally disabled, preschool students, grade school students. 200-400 individuals

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit - Participation of students in mental health counseling with a qualified social worker. Methodology - Rate of student participation.

Benefit - Program provides after school care services and resources, to assist ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) families with a safe and quality child care program which allows families to maintain self sufficiency and improve their quality of life.

Methodology - Rate of employment among targeted population.

Agency will be placed on a Performance Improvement Plan and/or sanctioned with corrective actions.
