a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The City of Hallandale Beach intends to reduce emissions and local air pollution stemming from public transportation by purchasing 9 fully electric buses to replace the propane fueled buses currently operating the City's Community Shuttle Program. To properly operate this program, the City, along with FDOT and the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency, will construct a parking and maintenance facility, and battery charging stations to support the EV fleet.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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This project provides the infrastructure for an electric mini bus system. The system will ultimately provide free environmentally friendly public transportation to the community.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The system will ultimately provide free environmentally friendly public transportation within southern Broward County and northern Miami-Dade County, connecting residents in the City of Hallandale Beach to key trip generators such as employment centers, malls and hospitals, and at no cost to users that rely on public transportation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents, visitors, and travelers within the City of Hallandale Beach. Greater than 800.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit - Avoiding additional greenhouse gas emissions.
