a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will replace water meters, infrastructure, that are presently read by City Staff with AMR meters that can be read from City Hall via radio signal. This will allow / assist City Staff to better monitor water consumption to isolate potential water loss areas within the City water system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Engineering Services to identify the planning and scope of the project along with drafting of the deliverable for the proposed project. The construction activities associated with replacement of infrastructure and Inspection services during construction.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services provided as a result of this project are water services and quality of service. Improved water loss could potentially decrease cost and limit service cost to the customer/public.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire population of Marianna and Jackson County, that are customers on the Marianna water system. It should also be noted Jackson County, along with all cities within the County have been designated by the Governor as a Rural Area of Opportunity, (RAO) formally Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (RACEC).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome is to have an infrastructure system that meets all Federal, State and Local Code requirements for health and safety concerns. The primary way of measuring performance is to have the City's Water Division provide monthly water loss reports showing any decrease in water well run times. The project will also provide measured improvements to the infrastructure within the RAO designated community allowing for additional water capacity in our downtown business district.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contracting agency, City of Marianna has establish a Critical Path with date specific targets for pre-development. Once bids are received and awarded for the project, the contract will have specific contract completion dates, if not met contractor will be subject to Liquidated Damages, assessed on a daily basis.
