a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

FSW's goal is to become the higher education institution of choice for students looking to gain credentials in information systems technology and cyber security. In order to accomplish this requires an investment in state-of-the-art technology.



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#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

To educate and train cyber security professionals, utilizing state-of-the-art technology. New technology that would support FSW's cyber security program includes robots with full programming capabilities to include vision and artificial intelligence, Internet of Things smart devices, as well as general updates to existing computers and hardware.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Instruction to students is the primary purpose. In addition, FSW will offer a variety of co-curricular events and trainings open to the public.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The primary population to be served are students enrolled in the Bachelors in Information System Technology, Associate in Cyber Security Operations, Associate in Network Systems Technology and an Associate in Computer Programming and Analysis. Historically enrollment for the computer science programs is approximately 250 in the Fall term.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit will be an improvement in the quality and relevancy of the instruction delivered to the students. Installation of the current, modern technology and increase access to programs will improve the employment opportunities for graduates of these programs. The college monitors student retention, graduation, job placement/continuing education, and earnings among other measures as part of accreditation and state-mandated reporting.
