a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Replace old portable/mobile emergency radios, dispatch consoles, equipment/software for use by multiple agencies-county services, EMS, Fire Rescue, law enforcement, with SLERS-2 APCO P-25 Phase 2 system. Meets DMS Law Enforcement Communications Plan: direct communications with all state law enforcement agencies, 24/7/365 monitoring to ensure safety of first responders, citizenry, protection of life, health & property in the Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds used to purchase, Install, test & train mandatory SLERS-2 APCO Standards P-25 Phase 2 compliant portable/mobile radios, dispatch consoles, software/hardware in Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern to be used by multiple agencies for greater interoperability for all users in emergencies, hurricanes, hazardous events, and daily operations of public safety.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Communications on the SLERS-S APCO Standards P-25 radio system provides greater interoperability for all users, improved response to safe lives, reduce fatalities/injuries property damage, etc. Maintains a safe, healthy, quality of life. Provides safety professionals the required equipment to respond to emergencies, accidents, weather related events to serve the citizens efficiently and effectively.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Population served is residents, citizens, visitors and businesses of Wakulla County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, F.S.). Greater than 37,000 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit is installed and operational SLERS-2 APCO P-25 Phase 2 radio systems for use by multiple county agencies; Meets DMS Law Enforcement Communications Plan, 2018 Edition; interoperability is key to protecting the general public from harm; cost efficient and effective; and certification of the project.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Non-payment of invoices until milestones achieved; and implementation of corrective action plan. Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
