d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

400-800 youth are going to be served. People with poor mental health, poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, homeless youth, grade school students, high school students, university/college students, currently or formerly incarcerated persons, drug offenders (in criminal justice), and victims of crime.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase access to fresh foods; increased physical activities; nutrition education classes; cooking classes; increases in fresh produce distribution; increase in physical activities offered in the community; number of cooking and nutrition classes offered; create community gardens; provide fresh food in disadvantaged communities; provide nutrition education; increased access to fresh food; scores on nutrition education post tests; create community gardens and community clean ups; numbers of gardens and clean ups created and done; youth employment, number of youth employed and paid through the program.
