a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will provide high school students in Escambia County the pathway to earn their high school diploma while also receiving hands on training to earn a Technical Certificate, or Associate of Science degree concurrently.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The funds will create a charter academy and curriculum for high school students to earn their high school diploma along with technical certificates and in career-ready technical fields.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The PSCCTCA will provide dual enrollment high school students the opportunity to earn college credits, hands-on technical skills training, and an Associate of Science degree.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

High school students in Escambia County who wish to pursue a technical career path upon graduation, and employers in Escambia County in need of employees with Technical Certificates. 80 high school students (grades 11-12) are projected to be enrolled in the first year of the program and 160 high school students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The PSCCTCA will improve the quality of education in Escambia County by offering high school students a career Technical Certificate or Associate of Science degree. The number of students enrolled in The PSCCTCA will measure the outcome.
