4. Project/Program Description

Short-term residential treatment beds are utilized by individuals with a primary mental health disorder with possible cooccurring issues while they await placement in a state mental health treatment hospital. The funds will be used to contract for the operation of 12 short-term community-based residential treatment beds and community-based services for post discharge. In some instances, individuals who receive treatment in a short-term residential treatment facility may end up being diverted from placement in state hospitals and instead receive treatment in the local community.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of acquiring additional short-term residential treatment facility beds is intended to reduce admission to state mental health treatment facilities through diversion to the short-term residential treatment facilities. The reduction of state facilities is a goal identified by the Department of Children and Families. Additionally, the availability of such beds will act as a harm reduction for individuals who would otherwise go without treatment and may possibly become involved in criminal activities.



b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used to contract for 12 short-term residential treatment beds and services for individuals with a primary mental health need and/or possible co-occurring issues while they await placement in a state mental health treatment hospital. These beds will be utilized in Hillsborough County as the county does not have any of these beds allocated through current appropriations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Residential treatment facilities use medical and clinical procedures for individuals who have mental health and/or cooccurring problems. Facilities provide treatment in a secure environment. Individuals receive individual and group therapy and have access to their outpatient community provider and family members who will ease their transition back into the community when treatment is complete. The funds will be used to contract for 12 short-term residential treatment facility beds and services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elderly persons; persons with poor mental/physical health; jobless persons; economically disadvantaged persons; homeless; university/college students; currently/formerly incarcerated persons; victims of crime; individuals with cooccurring mental health and substance abuse issues. The number of individuals expected to be served annually is 50-100.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A reduction in admissions to the state mental health treatment facilities through diversion to short-term community-based residential treatment facilities. This will be measured by the state's database. The beds will also act as a harm reduction for individuals that would otherwise go without treatment and possibly become involved in criminal activities. This will be measured by pre- and post-jail booking data.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The entity that will handle the contracting, Central Florida Behavioral Health Network, specifies penalties for nonperformance within their contract.
