**4. Project/Program Description**

Partnering with Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department to upgrade drainage on SW 27th Street from SW 27th to SW 30th Avenue. Upgrades will include removal of existing water mains, installation of 2,688 linear feet of new 8-inch Ductile Iron Pipe, service connections, and fire hydrants along no-outlet roads. This project also includes roadway reconstruction, ADA compliance upgrade, valley gutters and landscaping (trees). Widening of street to reduce potential safety hazard of very narrow streets. The streets will also be widened to reduce potential vehicular traffic and pedestrian safety conflicts/hazards in the existing. This project will increase flood protection and provide safe routes to schools and parks for area residents.

Protect home and property from the perils of flood, improve pedestrian and vehicular safety, improve the quality of life for the residents.

Design, construction, and project administration.

The target population is the neighborhood of Golden Pines in Miami with an estimated population of 15,160.

**e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?**

Reduced flooding on narrow streets reducing home, and property damage from seasonal flooding. Improved vehicular and pedestrian safety by lowering the saturation level of neighborhood streets during flooding and shortening the time roads are submerged. These benefits will be measured by comparing the number of vehicular and pedestrian accidents pre and post construction; comparing the number of flooding complaints before the construction is started and after the project is constructed by using sensors and on-site inspections.

**f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?**

Failure to meet deliverables or performance measures should subject the City to an audit and depending on the results of the audit the City could be liable for sanctions up to revocation of funding.
