The weapons detection system will enhance courthouse security by detecting and preventing unauthorized weapons from entering the premises.

The Duval County Courthouse serves the nearly 1 million citizens of Duval County and receives more than 2,500 visitors a day.

The weapons detection system will dramatically improve law enforcements ability to detect firearms being carried into the Duval County Courthouse. Its success can be measured by the number of firearms that are detected by the system and subsequently prevented from entering the premises.
