The project drainage area is approximately 366 acres. The Sea Pines neighborhood suffers from flooding events due to inadequate conveyance and storage of stormwater. The proposed project consists of the design and construction for a new stormwater conveyance systems and storage ponds within the Sea Pines neighborhood.
