4. **Project/Program Description**

Petit Lane connects Calienta Street to Shoal Line Boulevard, a Hernando County collector roadway along the coast of Hernando County. Calienta Street via Petit Lane accesses the county boat ramp, several commercial properties (including sea food sales and distribution), and on the north is Hernando Beach, a coastal subdivision. Currently, stormwater and roadway improvements are being designed on Calienta Street and Petit Lane along with the realignment of Petit Lane to align with Flamingo Boulevard which will remove the major skews at the intersections of Calienta Street and Shoal Line Boulevard. The current skew creates severe sight issues when entering and exiting both Calienta Street and Shoal Line Boulevard. Both Calienta Street and Petite Lane will be reconstructed as one project.

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Completion of the construction of Calienta Street and intersection improvements for the Petit Lane realignment to Flamingo Boulevard, which will improve the accessibility and safety of entering and exiting traffic at Petit Lane and Flamingo Boulevard. The realignment will remove the major skew at the intersections of Petit Lane/Shoal Line Blvd and Petit Lane/Calienta Street.

Construction activities to build the designed improvements for Calienta Street and Petit Lane/Flamingo Blvd.. The project will be competitively bid to increase economic stimulus in the area.

Improvements to this roadway and intersections would not only improve access for evacuation of the subdivision and the commercial properties during a disaster, but also improve safety during everyday operation for the public and tourists traveling to the commercial properties, the subdivision, and boat ramp.

The general population of Hernando County and tourists visiting coastal businesses will be served by this project.
