FRESH FUTURES High-Risk Juvenile Crime Prevention and Juvenile Justice Reform Funding Request: \$875,000

Need:

DJJ reports crimes by juvenile offenders has resurged after declining statewide annually since 2008.

Fresh Futures, a Jacksonville based non-profit with a stellar record working with High-Risk Juveniles, needs funding to continue its work to:

- **Facilitate Juvenile Justice Reform and record expungement**
- **Reduce youth crime and recidivism**
- **Increase youth academic performance and communications skills**
- **Improve youth character development processes, social skills and educational outcomes**
- **Move youth offenders toward 100% employment and/or academic enrollment**

Overview:

FreshMinistries in Jacksonville has emerged as an innovator and top performer in youth crime prevention. Its youth program is designed specifically to prevent recidivism in adjudicated youth (program cohort 1) and juvenile delinquency in high-risk non-adjudicated youth (program cohort 2). The pilot program, formerly known as Fresh Path, was funded by the US Department of Labor's Face Forward 2 grant. The grant, which expired in December of 2016, received outstanding accolades from the federal government.

Fresh Futures, offers a new path to youth who have been involved with the criminal justice system or at high risk of becoming involved in criminal activities. It provides program services for both the youth and their families. The core program addresses educational and employment barriers to help both court-involved and high-risk youth obtain a strong educational foundation and the life skills needed to successfully return to school, experience gainful employment, and build their confidence to resist negative peer pressure and make better decisions - which reduces the risk of re-offending and/or offending. After youth complete the program extensive follow-up continues to assist the youth in refining his/her newly acquired positive decision making skills and educational journey.

Pilot Program Outcomes (6/2014 – 12/2016) for 275 Adjudicated Youth Completing Program:

- **95% of drop-outs re-enrolled in school**
- **65% entered vocational/occupational training programs**
- **73% had juvenile records expunged and or sealed upon successful completion of program and probation/diversion requirements**
- **100% completed work-readiness and life-skills training/counseling programs**
- **73% received employment**
- **93% had criminal charges dismissed after program completion**
- **97% of high risk, non-adjudicated youth completing programs remain uninvolved with the court system**
- **8% recidivism**
