I listened to the Supreme Court oral arguments over the weekend and to today's Senate committee meeting, and believe this method will satisfy the Court.

# Proposal: Numbering the Senate Districts for Reapportionment

## Rationale:

Neither history, geography, ordinal numbers, nor the coin knows where incumbents are nor when they were elected nor whether they will run again in two or four years.

- Step 1:** Determine the districts, setting the boundaries as the committee sees fit.
- Step 2:** Number the districts rationally (in order) based on geography (historically), from west to east, then north to south according to each district's western most longitude and then northern most latitude.
- Step 3:** Flip a coin to determine whether the **original** numbering (odds and evens) is kept (heads) or whether the numbers are flipped (tails) according to the table below:

## Coin Flip Procedure:

- a. Have the **Secretary of the Senate** conduct the coin flip.
- b. Before the flip, the **Secretary** shows the coin to all members present to identify the head and tail sides.
- c. The **Secretary** flips the coin at a public committee meeting from the witness lectern to the floor before the committee.
- d. Have the **Senate Sergeant-at-Arms** guard the coin after the flip so it remains undisturbed.
- e. The **Sergeant** visually inspects the coin toss result and declares the outcome, without touching the coin.
- f. The **Secretary** visually inspects the coin toss result and confirms the outcome.
- g. Allow all desiring committee members present to inspect the result as the coin lies on the floor.
- h. Move the committee to accept the result of the coin toss.
- i. Allow any public witnesses present to inspect the result.
- j. Direct the Sergeant to retrieve the coin.

Dear Senator Gaetz,

I am writing you with a major concern over the impact of redistricting on those of us who live in Lely Resort in Naples. I had originally written to Senators Richter and Bullard, but, unfortunately, my letter was too late to have any impact on the Senate plan that was passed. Now that the Senate redistricting plan is being revised, I would like to surface the issue again, and urge you to consider it as you develop a new plan.

Lely Resort is a community with clearly defined boundaries. It should be recognized as such for the purpose of electing officials to represent us in Tallahassee as well as Washington. The majority of residents in Lely Resort purchased homes here because of the community, which is extremely active. While we live in a variety of home styles ranging from small condos to houses priced over \$1 million, everyone has a strong sense of belonging to a single community, much like a small town. We share the same interests and concerns about our homes and the area in which we live.

We also share the same concerns as all residents of Naples and the Southwest Coast, which are very different than those of Miami and the East Coast. Outside of Lely Resort, residents belong to groups throughout Naples. They look to Naples for their churches, recreation, and cultural activities. The 2012 redistricting provided an opportunity to address communities like Lely Resort and to keep them together as single entities. It failed miserably.

Both the 2012 House and Senate redistricting plans divide Lely Resort in half. One half shares their State Representative and State Senator with the East Coast. The other half shares a State Representative and State Senator with Naples. While the House plan has been approved and will leave one half of Lely Resort with a Representative on the other side of the state, it is still possible to correct the error made with the Senate

Districts. By including the Lely Resort community as a whole in a Senate district focused on the Western portion of Collier County with Naples, the issues of the community can be addressed properly in Tallahassee. By shifting the northern boundary of the Senate district line down to Collier and pushing the line further east within Collier, the concept of following County Boundaries would be addressed and would add more of Collier County to the district. In fact, the majority of the agricultural businesses we serve and specifically, the strawberry farmlands which have earned Plant City the reputation as the "Winter Strawberry Capital of the World" are actually located in the surrounding unincorporated area.

For these reasons, I feel that both eastern Hillsborough County and the City of Plant City would be best served by continuing to be included within the same Florida Senate district. Thank you very much for your service and consideration.
