1	15	18	Senate	<b>DOC / CJEC BUDGET AMENDMENT.</b> Amends s. 216.262, F.S. to allow the Executive Office of the Governor (EOG) to request additional positions and appropriations from unallocated general revenue during the 2018-2019 fiscal year for the Department of Corrections (DOC) if the actual inmate population of the DOC exceeds certain Criminal Justice Estimating Conference forecasts. The additional positions and appropriations may be used for essential staff, fixed capital improvements, and other resources to provide classification, security, food services, health services, and other variable expenses within the institutions to accommodate the estimated increase in the inmate population, and are subject to LBC review and approval. 2	16	19	Senate	<b>COURT TRUST FUND LOAN.</b> Amends s. 215.18, F.S. to provide chief justice the authority to request a trust fund loan.	Same

13		SECTION 34. From the recurring funds in Specific Appropriation 614, Specific Appropriation 627, and Specific Appropriation 629K, the sums of \$3,227,082, \$272,918, and \$500,000 respectively, from the General Revenue Fund are provided to the Department of Corrections for the purpose of funding salary increases for those certified correctional officers employed pursuant to the terms of the operations and management services contracts with the Department of Management Services. Such funds must be used to provide salary adjustments to employees certified as correctional officers and holding positions similar to the correctional officers (class code 8003), correctional officer sergeants (class code 8005), correctional officer lieutenants (class code 8011), and correctional officer captains (class code 8013) employed by the Department of Corrections. Such salary adjustments are intended to increase each employee's annual base rate of pay to an amount equal to the applicable class minimums used by the Department of Corrections and in effect on January 10, 2018, or by \$2,500 annually, whichever amount is greater. The Department of Management Services shall modify existing contracts by August 1, 2018, to provide the funding for the salary adjustments.	SENATE	13
