1	38	74	<b>FIXED CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS/DEEPWATER HORIZON.</b> Amends s. 216.181 to authorize the Legislative Budget Commission to increase amounts appropriated to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission or the Department of Environmental Protection for fixed capital outlay projects. The increase in fixed capital outlay budget authority is authorized for funds provided to the state from the Gulf Environmental Benefit Fund administered by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, the Gulf Coast Restoration Trust Fund related to the Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities, and Revived Economies of the Gulf Coast Act of 2012 (RESTORE Act), or from British Petroleum Corporation (BP) for natural resources damage assessment restoration projects. Any continuing commitment for future appropriations by the Legislature must be specifically identified.	Identical	
2	39	75	<b>LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUND LOAN.</b> Amends s. 215.18, F.S. to authorize loans to land acquisition trust funds.	Identical	
3	40	76	<b>DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM THE LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUND WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO OTHER AGENCIES' LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUNDS.</b> Provides that proportionate share of revenues to be transferred to a land acquisition trust fund from the DEP LATF will be calculated by dividing the appropriations from each of the land acquisition trust funds for the fiscal year by the total appropriations from the DEP LATF and the land acquisition trust funds within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Fish and Wildlife Commission, and the Department of State for the fiscal year. DEP will transfer a proportionate share of the revenues in the DEP LATF on a monthly basis to the land acquisition trust funds within DACS, FWCC and DOS and shall retain a proportionate share of the revenues in the DEP LATF. Total distributions to a land acquisition trust fund within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the Fish and Wildlife Commission and Department of State shall not exceed the total appropriations from such trust fund for the fiscal year.  Authorizes DEP to transfer funds from LATF to DACS, DOS and FWC land acquisition trust funds equal to the difference between amounts appropriated in 18-19 GAA and the amounts actually transferred.  Authorizes DEP to advance funds from the beginning cash balance in the LATF to the LATF in FWC amounts needed for cash flow purposes based on detailed expenditure plan. Requires DEP to prorate amounts transferred quarterly to recoup the amount of funds advanced by June 30, 2019.	Identical

The authority of the AES, includes the state mosquito control program, pesticide registration, testing and regulation, and feed, seed, and fertilizer production inspection and testing. ## **PROPOSED LANGUAGE: NATIONAL SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM**

Section 45. In order to implement Specific Appropriation 1542 of the 2019-2020 General Appropriations Act, and notwithstanding ss. 216.181 and 216.292, Florida Statutes, the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services may submit a budget amendment, subject to the notice, review, and objection procedures of s. 216.177, Florida Statutes, to increase budget authority for the National School Lunch Program when necessary ~~due to an increase in the number of school meals expected to be served~~. This section expires July 1, 2020.

**PROPOSED LANGUAGE: PEST CONTROL TRUST FUND**

Section X. In order to implement Specific Appropriations 1464 through 1473 of the 2019-2020 General Appropriations Act, subsection (1) of section 409.2567, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

570.441 Pest Control Trust Fund.-

(4) In addition to the uses authorized under subsection (2), moneys collected or received by the department under chapter 482 may be used to carry out the provisions of s. 570.44. This subsection expires June 30, 2020 ~~2019~~.

## **PROPOSED LANGUAGE: WATER SUPPLY PLANNING**

Section X. In order to implement Specific Appropriation 1401 of the 2019-2020 General Appropriations Act, subsection (1) of section 570.93, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

570.93 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; agricultural water conservation and agricultural water supply planning. -

(1) The department shall establish an agricultural water conservation program that includes the following:

(a) A cost-share program, coordinated ~~where appropriate~~ with the United States Department of Agriculture and other federal, state, regional, and local agencies when appropriate, for irrigation system retrofit and application of mobile irrigation laboratory evaluations and for water conservation and ~~as provided in this section and, where applicable, for water quality improvement pursuant to s. 403.067(7)(c).~~
