In accordance therewith, the moneys in the following items are authorized to be expended for the enumerated authorized capital outlay projects.</p> <p>The sum designated for each project is the maximum sum to be expended for each specified phase of the project from funds accruing under Article XII, section 9(a)(2) of the Florida Constitution. The scope of each project shall be planned so that the amounts specified shall not be exceeded, or any excess in costs shall be funded by sources other than this appropriation.
