- 4. Project/Program Description:

The City of Coral Gables has 2 stormwater pump stations, more than 51,000 linear feet of french drains, and 2,436 catch basins throughout the city; unfortunately most of this critical infrastructure is old and deteriorating; most of the French drains have been compromised due to root intrusion, making them obsolete. The City has diligently engaged in root cutting in the stormwater system but this solution is a mere bandaid due to the excessive number of French drain pipes that are compromised. In fact, many of the existing catch basins are actually auger holes, auger holes do not meet current environmental standards for holding contaminants such as nitrogen and phosphorus. This project, which takes a comprehensive approach to improving the City's storm-water infrastructure, includes the removal and replacement of all the auger holes with actual catch basins structures with their respective French drains.
