The City of Punta Gorda seeks funding support for construction of drainage improvements in the Boca Grande Boulevard area. The project meets these four criteria of the 2018 319(h) grant requirements: swales and bio-swales; planting for bank stabilization and littoral planting; BMPs that treat stormwater runoff before it enters a major conveyance system; and erosion control practices that prevent soil/sediments from polluting nearby water bodies, such as road bed stabilization with rocks/plants.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this project is to provide drainage improvements for the Boca Grane neighborhood in the City of Punta Gorda. Eliminate standing water, reduce risk of flooding structures, reduce habitat for mosquitos, increase ability to maintain the appearance of the neighborhood, increase property values and increase quality of life for the residents of this area, align the neighborhood with the rest of the city in ridding the community of standing water within 72 hours of the last rainfall. Stormwater treatment will be provided in an area which currently does not have any treatment.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Swales and bio-swales. Planting for bank stabilization and littoral planting. BMPs that treat stormwater runoff before it enters a major conveyance system. Erosion control practices that prevent soil/sediments from polluting nearby water bodies, such as road bed stabilization with rocks/plants.
