- 4. Project/Program Description:

To design a 6,000 sq.ft. Emergency Management Office/Operations Center facility for a min. Category 4 storm & paved parking, located on County owned .55 acre parcel. Current facility cited for non-compliance State EOC requirements, consists of 2-stories built in 1926 originally used as the County Jail; has perforated metal screen shutters installed on the windows throughout the entire building; repairs to the leaky roof were made following the 2004 hurricane season. The general exterior wall construction found in the building is 12" cast-in-place concrete walls with unknown rebar spacing. Specific wind design is not available for the building, roof is flat without overhang & made of cast-in-place concrete with covering that consists of built up roofing without gravel & evidence of visible ponding. There is a parapet wall 4" with scuppers located in at least 2 of the walls. An emergency power generator is on site & securely anchored. No interior safe spaces.
