11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

To help the young people in our schools, the future leaders of our community, to develop the behavioral and emotional strength they need as they mature into healthy, responsible young adults. This is a one time request to conduct a pilot study. If successful, multiple sources of funding will be pursued.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

In cooperation with the Collier County Public Schools (CCPS) and local private schools the David Lawrence Center Mental Health Center, Inc. (DLC) is exploring the use of a nationally recognized, validated, and reliable screening tool for teachers to assess students on their social and emotional skills. Research has shown that inappropriate conduct resulting in disciplinary action has been significantly reduced through increased focus on strengthening the social and emotional skills of those students who exhibit behaviors categorized as "needs instruction,". Once the pilot is completed, an assessment of the program will be made by the participating schools and DLC to expand, change, or discontinue the program. d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Students who need stronger social and emotional skills will be identified and either receive coaching in the classroom or, if their needs go beyond what is available in the classroom, be encouraged to receive counseling by professionals in the community. If the program is successful, teachers will be able to focus more of their time on educational instruction and less time on disciplinary actions.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Kindergarten through 8th grade students in both public and private schools in Collier County. For the pilot, DLC is looking to conduct this project in two elementary and two middle schools with a maximum of approximately 4,000 students. DLC hopes for at least a total of 50% participation in all four schools.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

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The expected benefit of the pilot is to prove that this method of strengthening social and emotional skills improves overall student engagement and performance; and, if the pilot is successful, ultimately seeing this program adopted by all public and private schools in Collier County. The methodology is a nationally recognized, validated, and reliable screening tool called DESSA-mini.

- g. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

 DLC hopes to have at least 50% participation of all eligible students in the schools where the pilot is conducted. The goal is to achieve a 5% improvement in the scoring of social and emotional skills as measured from the beginning of the school year to the end of the school year. If DLC is unable to conduct the pilot in at least one school or has less than 250 students participating, DLC will not proceed. Funding would cease effective with a decision to discontinue the project and only costs incurred through this date would be reimbursed. Assuming the pilot proceeds as expected, quarterly progress reports, due within 30 days of the end of each calendar quarter, will be provided by DLC.
