Fire rescue services to residents of Wausau

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The residents of the Town of Wausau; > 400.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

There would be a new fire house for the Town of Wausau which would allow the Town to properly store, maintain, and secure their fire rescue equipment and vehicles. An increase in the level of fire rescue services including quicker response times and more reliable service to the residents. A decrease in the equipment maintenance costs due to proper storage and accessibility and a reduction in replacement costs due to a decrease in theft of equipment. The construction of this project would require workers in the building and construction trades to complete the project. These new work opportunities would provide a measure for job opportunities to the local area. Fire rescue response time and O&M costs would provide a measure for the success of the constructed fire house.

- g. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

  The Town will award the contract through a bid process. The bid documents will provide documentation for liquidated damage costs for project duration overruns. The bid documents will also require the contractors to provide performance and payment bonds which will protect the Town and subcontractors working on the project. A 10-percent retainer be withheld from all payments to the Contractor to provide quality assurance throughout the construction process.
