Thousands of Okaloosa and Santa Rosa County residents leaving Hurlburt Air Force Base are severely impacted by the traffic back up as this school enters the traffic each work day. By having buses that can move students off the base release cycle, traffic on base will be greatly improved helping with force readiness and potential future Base, Realignment and Closure commissions (BRAC).

The active duty military and civilian employees at Hurlburt AFB who are now unable to easily commute home after work, and impacting on-base traffic.

A reduction in Hwy 98 traffic at peak hours. FDOT and Okaloosa County Public Works have conducted surveys of the current situation, and results will be measured against those surveys.
