Funds will be used within the capital project to replace the 51-year-old Venice Public Library, which was closed due to environmental issues. A new library has been designed to serve the community.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The services and activities provided by the previous library were considered to be essential to the citizens of the Venice area. Replacement of the library has been identified as a Major Initiative for Sarasota County and residents of Venice have been vocal in recognizing library resources as a priority for their daily quality of life. The Venice Library has a long tradition of educational enrichment and arts/cultural programming that brings together residents, seasonal visitors, children, teens, and families in a learning center environment.
