The properties in the area are currently on septic and must roughly 20% of their property depending on the acreage for drainage and rentention. This project will alleviate commercial property owners of this requirement and facilitate opportunities for expansion, improvement, and increase property values. The project also involves roadway improvements to alleviate heavy traffic backup issues on Davie Road and increase pedestrian safety significantly.
