Since the advent of Medicaid managed care, it has become even more difficult for rural community transportation coordinators to provide accessible transportation to non-Medicaid transportation disadvantaged citizens. These grant dollars are to be used for innovative projects designed to promote access for persons with disabilities, older adults, and people with low income to health care, employment, education and other lifesustaining activities. A 10% local match is required for the grants.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Competitive Grants will be awarded to non-urbanized community transportation coordinators who submit responsive grant applications to the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged. Utilization of the funds will depend on the grant applications that receive awards.

Since the funding is for a competitive grant program, the specific types of activities and services are unknown at this time. However, all activities and services would be geared towards increasing transportation access to the transportation disadvantaged population.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the transportation disadvantaged population residing within the rural areas of the state. It is unknown how many individuals will be served as it is dependent on the grant winners.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This funding is for the third year of the grant program, and the Commission for Transportation Disadvantaged has created a deliverables and penalties guide as part of the grant program. Ultimately, the benefit provided by these grants will be to increase access to transportation for the transportation disadvantaged population residing within the rural areas of the state. Utilizers of the innovative transportation disadvantaged grant initiatives would see increased transportation options in rural communities, which are currently inadequate in

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much of rural Florida, especially for the transportation disadvantaged. This would result in increased access to health care, employment, education, shopping and other life-sustaining activities which they otherwise would not have access to.
