4. Project/Program Description:

The Manatee Education Foundation and the Early Learning Community Task Force of Manatee County, which includes the School District of Manatee County (SDMC), the Manatee County Early Learning Coalition (ELC), the Manatee Community Action Agency (Head Start), and the South Florida Museum (SFM), have partnered to create a new, county-wide initiative designed to maximize the impact of Manatee County's educational resources for early learners. The goal of the initiative is to integrate the South Florida Museum's Mosaic Backyard Universe, a new educational resource in the community, into the county's network of early learning resources, enhancing the Early Learning Community Task Force's efforts to coordinate and deliver an integrated continuum of educational programs for the county's underserved Prekindergarten students and their families. This initiative will enable the community to create continuity between existing programs, maximize investments in new program development.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the LEARN initiative is to establish a coordinated, county-wide network or early learning resources. Funding will allow the Manatee Early Learning Coalition, School District of Manatee County, South Florida Museum, and Manatee Education Foundation to develop, coordinate, and deliver an integrated continuum of educational programs for the county's underserved Pre-K - 2 students, their families, and their educators.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

1) Early Learning Coalition (ELC), School District of Manatee County (SDMC) and South Florida Museum (SFM) collaboration on development and expansion of STEAM Machine outreach programs and follow up extension activities; 2) SFM and SDMC collaborate to expand SOAR in 4 programming to six schools in 2018-19 with monthly programs at SFM; 3) SFM to provide free admission and transportation to Mosaic Backyard Universe/North End Education Complex to all Title 1 Pre-K-2 students in Manatee County and to ELC supported private VPKs; 4) ELC, SDMC, SFM provide educator and parental development workshops; 5) SDMC and SFM continue hosting Ballard Satellite VPK at SFM

We expect to see the percentage of underserved/Title 1 students performing at grade level by grade 3 increase annually. It will take four years to see the results of the program and measure overall effectiveness. The ELC/SDMC's new "Universal Identifier" for each child in the county will enable us to evaluate the number of programs each child participates in, as well as their academic achievement.
