4. Project/Program Description:

The City of Hallandale Beach is requesting \$500,000 for the restoration and pollution mitigation of Chaves Lake. In 2014, the citizens of Hallandale Beach passed a \$60million General Obligation Bond to develop 7 parks including the Chaves Lake Park, a 17-acre park located in the NW section of the city. The full project includes pedestrian walkways, picnic shelters, passive open space, parking and recreational boating facilities. Unfortunately, after the Bond was issued the City discovered that the lake needs significant pollution mitigation to bring it up to state standards for water quality. This lake is critical because it serves as part of the I-95 drainage system and serves as drainage for the adjacent industrial area and minority community.
