**4. Project/Program Description:**

Miami Lakes Business Park Northeast Resilient Transportation Infrastructure Project (Project): This Project includes the design and construction of resilient and sustainable multi-modal transportation infrastructure to provide safe and convenient non-motorized transportation to jobs, educational opportunities, businesses, commerce, and the executive airport in the Town’s Eastern Business District. The Project will construct new ADA accessible sidewalks, bicycle lanes, and drainage infrastructure. The Project will incorporate a multifunctional design to provide significant benefits to support Complete Streets and green infrastructure that will assist in flood mitigation, pollution runoff reduction, heat island effects protection, and sustainable transportation promotion, increasing the resilience of the Town of Miami Lakes and Miami-Dade County.

**a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?**

Current corridors do not provide sidewalks or bicycle lanes. The Project's specific goal is to design and construct a resilient and sustainable multi-modal transportation infrastructure to provide safe and convenient non-motorized transportation to jobs, educational opportunities, businesses, commerce, and the executive airport in the Town's Eastern Business District. The Project will construct new ADA accessible sidewalks, bicycle lanes, and drainage infrastructure. The Project will incorporate a multifunctional design to provide significant benefits to support Complete Streets and green infrastructure that will assist in flood mitigation, pollution runoff reduction, heat island effects protection, and sustainable transportation promotion, increasing the resilience of the Town of Miami Lakes and Miami-Dade County.

**b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?**

The Project will provide new bicycle and pedestrian green infrastructure on the following corridors: 1) NW 153rd/151st Street from Miami Lakeway North eastbound to NW 57th Court; 2) NW 59th Court from NW 151st Street southbound to Miami Lakes Drive; 3) NW 57th Court from NW 151st Street southbound to Miami Lakes Drive; 4) NW 158th Street from NW 59th Avenue to NW 57th Avenue; 5) NW 163rd Street from NW 59th Avenue to NW 57th Avenue; and 6) NW 165th Terrace from NW 59th Avenue to NW 58th Avenue.

**c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?**

Currently, there are no bicycle lanes or sidewalks on all corridors. Direct services provided to the general population include improved access for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians, as well as low impact green stormwater infrastructure to minimize localized flooding for over 380 businesses in the Northeast Business District.

**d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?**

The target population served by this Project is the Miami Lakes Northeast Business District. The Project will provide critical transportation infrastructure for the Business Park East industrial and commercial district of over 380 businesses and approximately 6,600 employees, as well as the AVE Aviation and Commerce Center, a 2.5 million square foot mixed-use business park.

**e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?**

Currently, there are no bicycle lanes or sidewalks on all corridors. The Project will provide improved access for bicyclists and pedestrians as identified in the scope. In addition, the Project will design and construct low impact green stormwater infrastructure. The methodology for measuring outcomes includes bicycle and pedestrian trip counts, water storage and capacity levels, and water quality.

No payment will be made for deliverables deemed unsatisfactory by the agency.
