**1. Title of Project:** Golden Beach Center Island Stormwater Pump Station

**4. Project/Program Description:**

The project consists of the installation of a Tidewater Pump Station to assist in preserving the recently installed town-wide infrastructure in preparation for sea level rise. The pump station will consist of two (2) 10 horsepower pumps in an 8 foot diameter wetwell to remove the tidal water which permeates to the ground surface. The Town has invested \$20,000,000 in its infrastructure over the past 8 years and is taking one more step to prepare for the future of improvements. It is estimated that the cost of the pump station and its appurtenances will be \$900,000.
