4. Project/Program Description:

Atlantic Dunes Park is located at the southern extent of the Municipal Beach in the City of Delray Beach, 1605 S Ocean Blvd, Delray Beach, FL 33483. It is partially owned by Palm Beach County (County) and is managed by the City of Delray Beach (City) Parks and Recreation Department. It is lifeguard supervised by the Ocean Rescue Division. Atlantic Dunes Park is located on the Coastal Dune ecosystem and, historically, was a tropical maritime hammock, now suffering from invasive exotic plants on the dune; and inundation from stormwater and salt water from various storm events, which creates a water quality issue. This phase of the project will address stormwater and water quality management issues and improvements to the park through removal of invasive exotic plant species, restoration of the tropical maritime hammock, ADA access improvements including boardwalks and a barrier-free playground facility, educational kiosks and restroom facility improvements.
