The Project consists of furnishing and installing French Drains, catch basins, and manholes. Work also includes providing a Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plan and traffic control for the entire construction area; temporary pavement required to maintain local traffic; and permanent pavement restoration that shall be paid for within the payment line item for pipe or French drain installation, as applicable; full width milling and asphalt overlay of existing roadways; and replacing pavement markings. FDOT standards and specifications.

The local community will benefit from a reduction in street flooding. Improving the stormwater management system will also result in an improved quality of life for residents. Also, the service years and quality of existing road networks will be improved by the proposed improvements.
