This project is for the replacement of four (4) failed stormwater outfalls in the Eastern Shores and Pickwick Lakes communities. The outfalls discharge into the intracoastal and Snake Creek Canal (C-9) respectively. One of the outfalls has completely collapsed and has been repaired temporarily. The potential damage associated with the failure of these stormwater structures include flooding, development of sinkholes, and undermining of adjacent foundations of both public and private infrastructure.

 - Alleviate flooding, prevention of sinkholes, and damage to the foundation of adjacent public and private infrastructure.

 - The reconstruction of the outfalls will ensure a properly functioning drainage system that treats and transmits storm runoff from the neighborhood roadways to the canal.
