4. Project/Program Description:

Miami Lakes Business Park Southeast Resilient Transportation Infrastructure Project (Project): The Project includes the design and construction of resilient and sustainable multi-modal transportation infrastructure to provide safe and convenient non-motorized transportation to jobs, educational opportunities, businesses, commerce, and the executive airport in the Town of Miami Lake's (Town) Eastern Business District. The Project includes the design and construction of new ADA accessible greenways and trails, sidewalks, and bicycle facilities. The Project will incorporate a multifunctional design to provide significant benefits to support non-motorized transportation and enhanced landscaping which improves air quality, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, protects from the creation of heat island effects, addresses traffic congestion, and enhances connectivity in the Town and Miami-Dade County.

11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Currently, this Project corridor lacks sidewalks and connectivity. This Project includes the design and construction of new ADA accessible greenways and trails, sidewalks, and bicycle facilities. The Project will incorporate a multifunctional design to provide significant benefits to support non-motorized transportation and enhanced landscaping which improves air quality, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, protects from the creation of heat island effects, addresses traffic congestion, and enhances connectivity. Through the implementation of non-motorized transportation modes, the Town furthers its Strategic Plan commitment to becoming a resilient community in Miami-Dade County.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Project will provide new ADA accessible sidewalks and a bicycle and pedestrian shared use path on the following corridors: 1) NW 142nd Street from NW 60th Avenue to NW 57th Court; 2) NW 139th Street from NW 60th Avenue to NW 57th Court; 3) NW 58th Court from NW 142nd Street to NW 139th Street; 4) NW 57th Court from NW 142nd Street to NW 139th Street.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Currently, there are no sidewalks on all corridors. Direct services provided to the general population include improved access for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians. The Project will complete the mobility network for over 380 businesses in the Business East District. In addition, the Project will increase access to public transportation for over 6,600 employees.



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d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this Project is the Miami Lakes Business East District. The Project will provide critical transportation infrastructure for the Business Park East industrial and commercial district of over 380 businesses and approximately 6,600 employees, as well as, the AVE Aviation and Commerce Center, a 2.5 million square foot mixed-use business park.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Currently, there are no sidewalks on all corridors. Methodology for measuring outcomes include bicycle and pedestrian trip counts. The Project will provide improved access for bicyclists and pedestrians as identified in the Town and Miami-Dade County.
