Four of the City's current wastewater pumping stations are in need of immediate overhaul. The existing pumping stations are suffering from significant corrosion damage to piping, concrete, wiring, and controls. This damage is leading to operational difficulties and sewage overflow. The requested funds allow the City to continue transport raw sewage and treated wastewater in compliance with FDEP regulations to and from their Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF).

Improvements to the pumping stations will allow the City to continue providing reliable sewer service to its residents and greatly reduce the potential for sewer overflows.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

With the requested funds the City will contract the needed design, permitting, and construction of improvements to City's wastewater pumping stations.

The entire population of Bowling Green with municipal sewer connections will be served by this project (approximately 2,900 persons).

The proposed project will allow the City to comply with FDEP regulations regarding the management of sewage, protect the environment, and protect the general public from harm. Fully functional pumping stations will better handle sewer flows and minimize chances of overflows and reduce maintenance requirements. Successful construction and implementation of the project will allow operation of the pumping stations with a minimum of downtime. Maintenance logs may be used to confirm reduced downtime and occurrence of overflows.
