 - The Department of Revenue, in conjunction with property appraisers in Baker, Hardee, Desoto and Hendry counties will be able to obtain aerial photography

 - Citizens are able to access aerial photography on a statewide basis. Greater accuracy and equity in assessments in the named counties.

 - The target population is Baker, Hardee, Desoto and Hendry counties. Population served is 124,000

 - The method for measuring level of benefit would be qualitative and reflected in better accuracy of assessments and property identification. Because the aerial photography is oftentimes shared with other local governmental entities, level of benefit would be reflected in 911 programs, emergency management, planning and zoning, and building departments.
