11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

As many Puerto Rican businesses have expanded into Florida - and as we wish to encourage Florida based businesses to create business relationships and partnerships in Puerto Rico - Dynamic CDC will provide technical business information and guidance to facilitate this expansion such as the legal requirements, state tax responsibilities, and special initiatives for businesses seeking to expand into these two markets. Dynamic CDC will not encourage any business to cease operations in a market, but rather to expand and benefit both markets.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Dynamic CDC will organize workshops targeting, in particular, low-income, minority, and women-owned businesses. When doing intake of participating businesses, we will ascertain their business technical assistance requirements and provide requisite services through our staff or through collaborative CBO's. Professional services will be provided by outside professionals. For businesses seeking to enter the Florida market, we will provide matchmaking services and referrals to government, public-sector business agencies, and microloan and banking referrals, etc.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

As detailed in "b" above, we will provide direct technical business assistance, business assistance through a network of collaborating CBO's and professionals, workshops providing both educational speakers on a variety of business-related subjects and an opportunity to network, and staff familiar with the business markets of Florida and Puerto Rico to assist in business expansion and/or creating trading partnership in Florida.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population of this project are business people in the State of Florida who wish to further educate themselves on the rules and regulations of doing business in multiple markets, and who wish to expand their businesses - either through creation of new business partnerships and/or expansion of their business into a new market. We will target, in particular, low-income, minority, and women-owned businesses for these services. We expect to assist 120 individuals and businesses with these services.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefits of this project are: (a) a business community better informed on the rules, regulations, and benefits of doing business in the markets of Florida and Puerto Rico; (b) business owners who have made new business contacts in another market - thereby expanding their sales into two markets; and (c) businesses which have physically expanded their businessES into a second market. The Outreach & Intake officers - both for the Florida and Puerto Rico markets - will be charged with providing ongoing services and follow-up analysis.
