  - This project will improve the delivery of information technology programs and reduce the operational costs of the building.

  The Lee campus is Florida SouthWestern's largest campus, serving 8,862 students (fall 2018).
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
  - The expected benefit will be an improvement in the quality and relevancy of the instruction delivered to the students. Installation of the current, modern technology and increased access to programs will improve the employment opportunities for graduates of these programs. The college monitors student retention, graduation, job placement/continuing education, and earnings among other measures as part of accreditation and state-mandated reporting.
