- 4. Project/Program Description:

The CR 280A Connector Road project will consist of engineering, survey, design, permitting, and construction of an approximate 1.74 mile roadway. The new roadway would connect US Hwy 331 to CR 280A. The proposed roadway would provide two 12 foot travel lanes for a total roadway width of 24 feet. The roadway and associated stormwater infrastructure will be constructed within a 100 foot wide right of way. The project would include construction of at least one roadway bridge and a number of wetland crossings which will be finalized as part of the forthcoming design & permitting process.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

This area of Walton County, southeast of DeFuniak Springs, does not have direct access to US Hwy 331 which serves as the primary north-south arterial highway in Walton County. The CR 280 A Connecter Road would allow the traveling public a more convenient and direct route to US Hwy 331, would help relieve traffic congestion on US Hwy 331, reduce emergency response times to area citizens, provide a safer travel corridor, and decrease the travel times required to access the only hospital in north Walton County. This roadway project would also encourage economic development in and around the project vicinity.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of roadway and bridge.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The CR 280A Connector Road project would provide direct services to citizens by providing a more convenient and safer route to US Hwy 331. This would improve emergency response times and reduce travel time for citizens to the only hospital in north Walton County. This project would also encourage economical development in and around the project vicinity.
