4. Project/Program Description:

The City of Pembroke Pines, community services department, transportation division, operates a free senior transportation service that provides transportation from the home of a senior (55 years and older) to the Southwest Focal Point Senior Center to medical and dental appointments, pharmacy, other service agencies, post office, banks, grocery stores, etc. With this assistance, seniors in the Pembroke Pines community can stay independent. There are currently 16, 20-passenger buses and 5 cars operated by 7 full-time drivers and 1 part-time driver, 5 days a week for 10 hours a day. The yearly ridership is approximately 36,700 riders. Almost half of the vehicles have over 100,000 miles and as an aging fleet requires more repairs. This equates to down time for the vehicles and ultimately inhibits our service to the community. The total amount needed for this purchase is \$320,000 (4 buses at \$80,000) which the city will contribute 10% (\$32,000) thru a local match.
