4. Project/Program Description:

The need for mental health counseling is alarmingly on the rise, especially on college campuses. Specifically, there is an increase in presenting issues categorized as "severe", which includes self-injury and violence-related incidents deriving from depression, hopelessness and substance use. The peak onset for most mental health disorders is during young adulthood. The scarcity and lack of knowledge of affordable mental health resources made available to students has contributed to the rise of negative mental health symptoms that interfere with their academic performance, relationships and daily living. MDC aims to serve an expanded number of eligible students through its Single Stop program by having a full time Mental Health and Wellness Counselor at each campus to address these growing concerns.

Single Stop at Miami Dade College aims to improve student mental health for students by providing counseling, support and wrap-around services that will lead to increased student retention at the College.

The Counselors will screen and assess students' concerns and develop individualized treatment and safety plans. They will actively engage students in individual and group counseling sessions. The Counselors will also help raise awareness about mental health and facilitate support groups on campus.

 - The program will be open to all MDC students with a specific emphasis on students who meet at least one of the following criteria: In poor mental health or exhibiting a need for mental health support; unemployed; economically disadvantaged; at-risk; homeless; and/or currently or formerly incarcerated. The program will serve a minimum of 800 students.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

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Single Stop at Miami Dade College expects to: 1. Improve mental health; and 2. Improve student retention at the College. The aim is to reduce identified or reported concerns that negatively impact the daily of lives of students and allow students to be able to focus more on their academic goals and pursuits. This will be measured through treatment plans, observations and academic gains made by each student as noted in the attainment of academic milestones that lead them to earning a College credential.
