 - The goal of the project is to reduce the current 30% of unaccounted for water loss by reduction of the number of water main breaks and to improve drinking water quality for customers.

 Replacement of approximately 20,400 LF of 2" to 10" water mains, valves, fittings, fire hydrants, water services, and associated restoration.
