 - On an annual basis, more than 200,000 community residents and visitors, including more than 5,000 school students, visit the Gumbo Limbo Nature Center and over 44,000 take part in the public environmental programs and activities. In addition, over 9,000 stranded sea turtle hatchlings are released each year.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - The level of success can be determined by the number of visitors to the Nature Center, the number of people participating n the environmental programs and activities, and the number of sea turtles treated, rehabilitated and released back to the environment.
