  - Opportunities for a public wastewater disposal system in the region will promote future economic development along the State Road 207 corridor.
- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds? Installation of a wastewater system to promote economic development while promoting environmental awareness through the removal of outdated septic systems.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
  Citizens will be provided wastewater disposal opportunities not currently offered.

Currently an estimated 500 citizens are anticipated to receive a direct benefit from the installation of a wastewater system, however, the entire region will receive direct and secondary benefits in the form of economic benefit due to access to public wastewater system.

  - Reduction/Elimination of direct sewer discharge into the St Johns River that will result in elimination of FDEP direct discharge permits, BMAP nutrient reduction credits, and a reduction in residential complaints due to uninterrupted service.
